**2013 Desert Wind “Ruah”  
Wahluke Slope, Washington State**

**Regular 44<sup>99</sup>

This blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc is named for a Hebrew word meaning “breath” or “spirit.” Winemaker Greg Fries crafts the wine from grapes grown at the Fries’ Desert Wind estate vineyard on the Wahluke Slope in Washington State. Aromas and flavors of blackberry and cherry mingle with notes of earthy spice, toffee, cocoa and toasty vanilla.

**2013 Zuccardi “Q” Malbec  
Mendoza, Argentina**

**Regular 39<sup>99</sup>

Dark violet, with shades of black. Great floral aromas with rich, ripe blackberry, plum and chocolate notes melted with blackcurrant and cassis display an excellent balance and freshness. A persistent and velvety finish. \*James Suckling – “A Malbec with a firmness and brightness that focuses the fruit, plus light flower petal character. Full body, firm tannins. This is from vineyards in Altamira and Vista Flores.” 92 points

**2013 Amavi Cabernet Sauvignon  
Walla Walla, Washington**

Aromas of black cherry, plum and mocha intermingle on the nose, while dark fruit flavors like cassis give the wine a savory nuance on the palate. This wine shows a perfectly balanced, silky and elegant mouth feel with a rich finish. Blend: 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11% Cabernet Franc, 8% Merlot, 3% Malbec, 1% Syrah, 1% Petit Verdot.

**2013 Tenet Wine “The Pundit” Syrah  
Columbia Valley, Washington State**

**Regular 49<sup>99</sup>

Dark color with bright ruby highlights. Intense nose of dark cherry, cocoa, vanilla and hints of black truffles. The mouth feel is unctuous, with flavors of candied plum, cherry pie and vanilla. The finish is soft and seamless. Critical Acclaim – Wine Spectator – “Shows nice tension between the ripe, dark flavors and crisp, lively structure, featuring a sleek core of plum and smoky tea flavors that carry easily into the long and deftly balanced finish. A little cellaring should soften the tannins. Best from 2017 through 2020.” 92 points. #34 of Spectator’s top 100 Wines of 2015.

**2014 Hahn GSM  
California**

**Regular 39<sup>99</sup>  
Half off 19<sup>99</sup>**

Each of the three grape types blended into this wine adds distinctive aromas and flavors. Grenache contributes raspberry, strawberry and cherry flavors, while Syrah lends color, tannins and hints of blueberry and black pepper. The Mourvedre adds richness to the mid-palate and lengthens the dry finish. Wine Spectator – “Offers plenty of personality, with aromas of cherry, white pepper and smoky herb leading to zesty flavors of raspberry and licorice. Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. Drink now through 2022.” 90 Points.
